Syndication feed on Directgov

Since 2002 we've been syndicating opportunities from do-it.org.uk to Jobcentre Plus. However, in an effort to make information on public services more accessible, all Government departments are now making services available on Directgov rather than having separate websites.

In light of this, Jobcentre Plus has moved their job search onto [Directgov](#). Using this search, you can find volunteering opportunities from do-it.org.uk as well as paid positions. Since the end of last month people using the Jobcentre Plus website have been directed to Directgov. This change may lead to an increase in the number of volunteer enquiries you receive. Please do [contact us](#) if you notice a substantial increase in do-it.org.uk applications and enquiries over the coming months.

V- Base 3.0 Update

If you currently use V-Base and work in collaboration with other organisations in your area, we would really like to hear from you. To ensure that V-Base 3.0 will support your working practices we would like to gather your thoughts on the following:

- If you are from an organisation that has multiple branches currently using separate V-Base databases, how do you see this changing in the future?
- If you could, would you merge all your V-Base databases into one database, or would you want to keep separate data sets?
- If you are working with other organisations in your region/county what data would you like to share? Who would 'own' the data you're sharing?

Please note: If you are currently using V-Base 2.5 and you've set up a linked access database, we need to make you aware that we're unable to migrate these external databases to V-Base 3.0. It will not be possible for you to migrate data from anywhere else other than V-Base 2.5 and our support team will be unable to help with any technical difficulties relating to external databases.

Please also note that, as a minimum technical requirement to successfully run V-Base 3.0, you will need Windows XP installed.

Want to promote volunteering at your organisation?

Here at do-it.org.uk, we've recently launched a photo campaign to demonstrate the diversity of volunteers and volunteering opportunities in the UK – and we would love to have all our partners involved.



Volunteers all around the country are sending in photos of themselves holding up signs saying 'I'm doing it in...' or 'I'm doing it at...' and we're bringing them together on the photo-sharing website, [Flickr](#) to create a nationwide picture of volunteering. We're also looking for submissions from organisations who would like to promote their volunteers or volunteering programmes.

Submitting a photo is also a great way to promote a particular opportunity that you're advertising on do-it.org.uk. Accompanying each photo, we're including information about the organisation and a link through to the opportunity (see the [askTheSite](#) [peer advisors](#) photos for an example). We'll be promoting the campaign throughout the year – both to do-it.org.uk registered volunteers and through our other networks. It'll be earliest submissions that will end up getting the most traffic, so start taking photos and sending them in today. 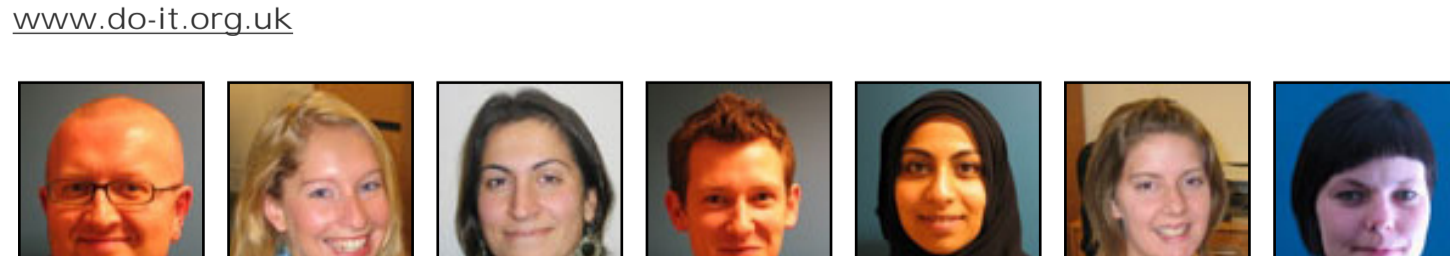
